Chaperone Bags

For each Marching Band Trip, we take a backpack on each bus with various supplies that might be needed. As the chair for the Chap Bags you will sort through the bags prior to marching band season making sure each is adequately stocked and throwing out any old items and purchasing new items as needed (you will be reimbursed). In addition, you will restock as needed through out the marching band season (which is minimal).

Clothing Sales Chair -- FILLED for 2015-2015 – Pete Kottra

This is for the T-shirts and Band Attire that is sold during Band Camp at the Potluck. This person works with the directors on coordinating with the vendor, gets samples for the potluck, is available during the potluck to take orders, places order and distributes the items on a Thursday night band practice during Marching Band.

Medical Assistants

Help is needed to inventory & re-stock the band's medical bag. (Cost is covered by the band.)

Volunteers should have some medical background – nurse, doctor, EMT, etc. and be willing to assist with minor medical needs of the students. Typical needs include small cuts, headaches, overheating, light headed, sick to stomach, twisted ankles, etc.

Volunteers should be willing to assist with at least one of following:

- Band Camp (one or more days or evenings)
- home football games
- marching/concert band trips

Band Camp Potluck Chair

Help is needed to organize/coordinate the family potluck held on the last night of band camp. Work with directors & volunteer coordinator(s) to:

- Order drinks through the school.
- Arrange and organize the set up (you will have volunteers to assist)
- Give direction to volunteers
- Clean up after the event (you will have volunteers to assist)

Uniform Team:

- During the summer: organize the uniforms and set up for measuring during band camp week
- Organize a team of volunteers during band camp week to measure and fit students for marching band uniforms
- Organize a team of volunteers to measure and fit students for concert band uniforms either during band camp week or on Thursday evening marching band practices.
- Instruct students on the care of their uniforms and how to properly wear their uniforms
- Be available at home football games and marching band trips to assist students with being in proper attire
- Assist with getting uniforms to and from the trailer and organizing the trailer set up
- Good organizational and leadership skills would be helpful
- Maintain paper work on assigned uniforms – including assigning, distributing and return of uniforms
